01JUL25 - Mawson Lake - Western End Across from Round About



Very pleasant day, my first fish in Mawson Lake. Using info from Brad and Greg set up on the left post on the Right side of the picture (taken from Nicks Café). One fish caught within the first half hour, and it was a stonker Carp, 74cm and 5.5kg. It is now cut into cubes in the freezer waiting for my next saltwater fish adventure. Great fight on 2kg line, couple of drag screaming runs. Water hens and ducks were an absolute pest. The white beaked waterhens diving and getting my baits. Moral of the story is once the berley was in the Waterhens must be able to pick up the scent and started diving. Age old decision to use berley or not. One trick was to throw bread in the water about 50m away then cast your line in.

01JUL25 - Shearwater Lake - Western End

Only had 40 minutes there but lake looked good. No bites but worth another try.
